




• Be Respectful - of everything - Work without disturbing others. Respect

Participation (30%)


- Each week you earn a participation grade in art. You begin the week with 100 points and may keep it or loose points depending on your participation. Participation grades are determined by:

 - Preparedness
 - Care of materials & supplies
 - Classroom safety



Art Journals / Daily Warm-Up


- Everyday you will begin with a 5 minute daily warm-up entry into your art journal. This consists of a drawing study and a written entry (typically vocabulary or technique suggestions).
- Art journals are graded every week on the last day of the week for completion and effort (not ability to mimic).

 Art projects are paced for you to achieve maximum creativity and craftsmanship.


 All art projects will have a planning packet that includes a checklist, a planning sketch, a rubric, and a reflection activity.
